OBJECTIVES

The 2015 Partners' Meeting focuses on:

- **Strengthening partnership and collaboration** within the Network, and
- Increasing the **visibility of land and tenure security in the ongoing global development processes.**

In line with the two focus areas above, the specific objectives for the 6th GLTN Partners' Meeting are:

1. Review the **GLTN tools' development processes** by Partners and Clusters and explore how joint tool development and implementation can be expanded;
2. Review how GLTN Partners are delivering at **country level** and how joint delivery can be enhanced;
3. Increase the **visibility of the land and tenure security issues** and of the GLTN agenda in the ongoing global development processes and agree on a strategy for engagement;
4. Improve **collaboration and coordination between Clusters and Partners** for improved delivery, report achievements of the last two years and make plans for the upcoming biennium under the lead of the newly elected IAB members;
5. Take stock of the progress made in the **implementation of the GLTN Phase 2 programme;**
6. Improve **GLTN's visibility within UN-Habitat.**
